The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Any unbaptized adults who wish to become members of the Catholic Church are invited to speak with Father Wynen by contacting the Parish Office. Adults baptized in other Christian churches or baptized Catholics who have not been Confirmed may also wish to speak with Father about completing their Initiation. Our process begins in September.

Summer series ...

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is an encounter with the Risen Christ who desires our healing and well-being. It is a sharing in the healing ministry of Christ through the Church. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick can be requested anytime one is seriously ill, experiencing significant emotional difficulty, facing surgery, or near death. There was a long period of our Catholic history when this Sacrament was referred to as *extreme unction* and was associated only with the moment of death – this is misunderstanding! In fact, the Church encourages the celebration of this Sacrament often so that the healing presence of Christ and the consolation of the Christian community might be close to the sick. In a situation where death is imminent, additional prayers for the commendation of the dying may be added, and Holy Communion may be given as *viaticum* (I am with you on the way) to nourish us spiritually for our final journey.

Each year at the Chrism Mass the Bishop blesses the *Oil of the Sick* which will be used by Priests in the Diocese as they celebrate this Sacrament. The Anointing of the Sick can be celebrated in a communal celebration in the Church, at the bedside of the sick, or in other situations when it is requested. In this Sacrament the Christian community expresses its solidarity with those who are ill and supports them with its prayer.

ONTARIO COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS & SURGEONS

Doctors in Ontario currently have the right to decline to provide non-emergency care that does not conform to their own moral and/or religious beliefs. This allows them to opt out of non-emergency care referrals, such as abortions, emergency contraception and other medical care that violates their own conscience. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) is now reviewing their Human Rights Code policy; the new policy will provide guidelines for physicians practicing medicine in Ontario. There is pressure on the CPSO to include language in their policy that would require doctors to offer or refer patients for such non-emergency care, forcing them to go against their own personal beliefs. The CPSO is accepting feedback on their website until August 5th






