WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

MARIAN CHAPEL & DAILY MASS

Daily Mass (Tuesday through Friday at 8:00 a.m.) will move from the Cathedral to the Marian Chapel (Cathedral Basement) on Tuesday, June 7. The Chapel has been refreshed – carpets removed, painted and newly lighted (LED fixtures). It is also more economical to cool the smaller space in the summer than to cool the Cathedral each morning for Mass.

BAPTISM AT MASS

Next Sunday we will resume the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism during Sunday Mass, which we had halted due to COVID concerns. CONVOCATION DAYS

Priests, Deacons and Pastoral Ministers of the Diocese will meet here at the Cathedral for a special Convocation led by Father Paul Turner – a noted liturgist, author and Rector of the Cathedral of the Diocese of St. Joseph-Kansas City. The meetings will offer an opportunity to reflect on re-opening the Church after the experience of COVID. Deacons and Pastoral ministers will meet on Thursday, June 23, while the Priests of the Diocese will gather on Friday, June 24th. Please pray for that these sessions will bear fruit.

ORDINATION OF DEACONS

Auxiliary Bishop Wayne Lobsinger will preside at the Ordination of Deacons on Friday, June 24 in the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King. Our own Jonathan Reitzel will be among the three Ordained that evening. These men – God willing – will continue their studies in the Fall and be ordained Priests for our Diocese next Spring. Please pray for them. The Ordination is at 7:00 p.m. on June 24th – all are welcome!

M McNALLY HALL LIGHTING

Conversion of McNally Hall lighting to LED fixtures has been completed. The kitchen lighting and Marian Chapel lighting have also been upgraded. Both spaces have been refreshed with some needed painting. This Summer, we will remove the carpet in McNally Hall to refresh the terrazzo floors underneath.

FEAST OF THE HOLY TRINITY

Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Holy Trinity – one God – three persons – the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Each time we make the *Sign of the Cross* we sign ourselves with the Holy Trinity and enter into the profound mystery of this relationship of pure love.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

As we approach the *Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)* next Sunday, it seems an opportune time to review a few basics in regard to the reception of Holy Communion.

1. Catholics receive Holy Communion in one of two ways only – either in the hand or on the tongue – we stand to receive Holy Communion as a sign of our reverence for the Lord.
2. If receiving in the hand ... be sure that your hands are open and free of anything – Kleenex, rosary, etc. Your right hand should cradle your left hand, like a throne. The minister says, “The Body of Christ.” We respond, aloud, “Amen.” The Sacred Host is placed on our hand. We take it with our right hand and place it in our mouth, immediately. Do not walk away holding the Sacred Host. It is to be consumed in view of the minister.
3. To receive on the tongue, be sure your mouth is open so that the Sacred Host may be placed on your tongue. If you choose this option, please only approach the Priest. We discourage this option at this time due to the ongoing pandemic concerns.
4. Non-Catholics may not receive Holy Communion at Mass because this is an act of *communion* with all that the Church teaches and believes. Non-Catholics may remain in their place and join us in prayer. The RCIA process begins in September for non-Catholics who wish to become members of the Church.
