

The Most Reverend D. DOUGLAS CROSBY, OMI, DD *Bishop of Hamilton*

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Today the Church celebrates the *Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity*. The opening prayer, or Collect, of today's Mass says:

God our Father, who by sending into the world the Word of truth and the Spirit of sanctification made known to the human race your wondrous mystery, grant us, we pray, that in professing the true faith, we may acknowledge the Trinity of eternal glory and adore your Unity, powerful in majesty.

Calling God "Father" is to imitate Jesus and his followers in the early Church. The name of Christ as "Word," of course, is strong in Saint John's writings beginning with the Prologue in the Gospel according to John. The name "Spirit of sanctification" is in the writings of Saint Paul and Saint John. The Collect prays that we, who have accepted the truths from the Councils and proclaim their Creeds at Mass, will continue to acknowledge the Trinity of God (in Persons) bu all the unity of God (in substance).

The Church's teaching about the Trinity reminds us that God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are <u>one</u> and the <u>same</u> God. The Divine Persons are distinct from one another. The purpose of the Divine Missions of the Son and the Holy Spirit is to bring us to share in the life, light, and love of the Trinity.

One day Saint Augustine was meditating on the mystery of the Blessed Trinity, strolling along the beach as he pondered. Lost in thought, he encountered a small child who had dug a little hole in the sand. With tiny bucket in hand, the youngster had begun making trips to the sea and back, pouring pails full of water into the hole in the sand. Observing this for a while, Augustine asked the child what he was doing. "I'm putting the ocean in a hole." Condescendingly, Augustine said, "But you can Whereupon, the youngster never do that." responded, "and neither can you ever figure out the Legend has it that the boy Holy Trinity." disappeared, because in fact he was an angel.

JUNE - MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART

June is the month of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We celebrate the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart on Friday, June 27th (8:00 a.m. Mass). This devotion recalls our relationship with the allredeeming love of Christ symbolized by His Heart. Historically, between 800 and 1000 AD there grew the use of the symbol of Jesus' heart to focus on the wounds of Jesus. Saint John Eudes (1601 – 1680) promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Apparitions to Saint Margaret Mary Alocoque between the years 1673-1675 tell of Jesus' concern about the coldness of the world's response to his love. He asked Saint Margaret Mary to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart as a symbol of His love for all people; encourage frequent reception of Holy Communion; and to observe holy hours and prayers to the Sacred Heart.

Father, we rejoice in the gifts of love we have received from the heart of Jesus your Son. Open our hearts to share his life and continue to bless us with his love.
