WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

FEAST OF THE SACRED HEART

Each year the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus takes place on the second Friday after Pentecost. This year it coincides with the Feast of the Birth of John the Baptist. The order of precedence of feasts means that the Birth of John the Baptist is observed on the 23rd of June this year, rather than the 24th. The Feast of the Sacred Heart is also the annual observance of the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests. Please pray all Bishops, Priests and Deacons, that they may be open to having hearts formed after the heart of the Master.

EMERGENCY CALLS AT HHS

Effective June 29, a new system for contacting the Priest on-call for each HHS site comes into effect. HHS switchboard will no longer contact a Priest in case of pastoral urgency at General, Juravinski, or McMaster Hospitals. Instead, a self-governed call-forwarding system has been established by the Hamilton Deanery. Each Hospital site will have a telephone number to call for urgent Pastoral care – anointing of the Sick and Dying. For other needs – spiritual counselling, reception of Holy Communion, or other pastoral needs – contact your own Parish Priest.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

As we celebrate the *Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)*, it seems an opportune time to review a few basics in regard to the reception of Holy Communion.

- 1. Catholics receive Holy Communion in one of two ways only either in the hand or on the tongue we <u>stand</u> to receive Holy Communion as a sign of our reverence for the Lord.
- 2. If receiving in the hand ... be sure that your hands are open and free of anything Kleenex, rosary, etc. Your right hand should cradle your left hand, like a throne. The minister says, "The Body of Christ." We respond, aloud, "Amen." The Sacred Host is placed on our hand. We take it with our right hand and place it in our mouth, immediately. Do not walk away holding the Sacred Host. It is to be consumed in view of the minister.
- 3. To receive on the tongue, be sure your mouth is open so that the Sacred Host may be placed on your tongue. If you choose this option, please only approach the Priest. We discourage this option at this time due to the ongoing pandemic concerns.
- 4. Non-Catholics may not receive Holy Communion at Mass because this is an act of *communion* with all that the Church teaches and believes. Non-Catholics may remain in their place and join us in prayer. The RCIA process begins in September for non-Catholics who wish to become members of the Church.


