The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Scaffolding has been removed from the North face of the Cathedral Basilica. We anticipate that the compound may be up for sometime into the Fall but the clean up has begun. Work is progressing very well on the bell tower. Our contractor hopes to begin removing scaffold from the upper levels soon. The cross at the top of the tower has new cladding replacing the original copper (later painted gold) cladding. The new material is similar to what is used to make the Canadian Loonie coin. It will appear to be bright gold and then will weather into a slightly less shiny look. The stone pinnacles on the Tower have been installed and those on the South face are nearing completion. We will be undertaking a project of restoring the great oak doors of the Cathedral on the South face and the Tower entrance. Each set of doors should take approximately two weeks to complete. We hope to minimize the inconvenience of the doors being "out of commission."

SANCTUARY ORGAN

Did you know that the Cathedral Basilica has two pipe organs? We know, of course, about the great organ with more than 4,000 pipes. There is also a *Sanctuary Organ* located on the East side of the Sanctuary in an upper room. This organ has 1,000 pipes. It is currently being refurbished by Casavant Freres of Quebec. We anticipate that it will be up and running in the Fall.
