WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

SUMMER BULLETINS

We will publish a bulletin on the weekend of July 3 and August 7. Other than those two Sundays, we will not have a weekly bulletin in the Summer. Regular weekly bulletins will resume on September 4.

EMERGENCY CALLS AT HHS

Effective June 29, a new system for contacting the Priest on-call for each HHS site comes into effect. HHS switchboard will no longer contact a Priest in case of pastoral urgency at General, Juravinski, or McMaster Hospitals. Instead, a self-governed call-forwarding system has been established by the Hamilton Deanery. Each Hospital site will have a telephone number to call for urgent Pastoral care – anointing of the Sick and Dying. For other needs – spiritual counselling, reception of Holy Communion, or other pastoral needs – contact your own Parish Priest.

MASS INTENTIONS

A venerable Catholic tradition is the offering of Masses for the dead. These intentions are published in our Parish bulletin for each Daily Mass. Contact our Parish Office if you would like to request an intention for a Daily Mass between now and the end of December. Masses for 2023 may be requested after November 1st.

All Masses must be "satisfied" here within one year, or are sent to Catholic missionaries.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

Having just celebrated the *Feast of the Body* and *Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)*, it seems an opportune time to review a few basics in regard to the reception of Holy Communion.

- 1. Catholics receive Holy Communion in one of two ways only either in the hand or on the tongue we <u>stand</u> to receive Holy Communion as a sign of our reverence for the Lord.
- 2. If receiving in the hand ... be sure that your hands are open and free of anything Kleenex, rosary, etc. Your right hand should cradle your left hand, like a throne. The minister says, "The Body of Christ." We respond, aloud, "Amen." The Sacred Host is placed on our hand. We take it with our right hand and place it in our mouth, immediately. Do not walk away holding the Sacred Host. It is to be consumed in view of the minister.
- 3. To receive on the tongue, be sure your mouth is open so that the Sacred Host may be placed on your tongue. If you choose this option, please only approach the Priest. We discourage this option at this time due to the ongoing pandemic concerns.
- 4. Non-Catholics may not receive Holy Communion at Mass because this is an act of *communion* with all that the Church teaches and believes. Non-Catholics may remain in their place and join us in prayer. The RCIA process begins in September for non-Catholics who wish to become members of the Church.

RCIA

This Fall we will resume the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* process in our Parish. The RCIA is the normal way through which adults prepare for the celebrations of *Baptism, Confirmation,* and *First Eucharist*. The process includes a series of sessions reflecting on the teachings of the Catholic Church, the Sacraments and the moral life. The Sacraments of Initiation are celebrated at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. Adults who were baptized in other Christian communities may also participate in the process and are then received into the full communion of the Catholic Church.

3-D SUMMER - FR. D

For many years, I have tried to practice a 3-D summer ... to approach life in a lighter way I tend to defer, delegate, and delay ... not necessarily in that order (and sometimes all at once). The point being is that summer should be a more relaxed time in the parish, but we don't relax from our participation in the life of the Parish community. Join us for the celebration of Sunday Mass, or if you are free on weekdays, come to daily Mass. Maintain a spirit of prayer during the Summer - even on holidays. Our part of the world is blessed with great warmth and beauty for these short months ... let's enjoy it before the snow comes again. A happy Summer break to all attending or teaching in our Schools. 
