

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

YEAR OF MERCY – Begins December 8th

Lord Jesus Christ, you have taught us to be merciful like the heavenly Father, and have told us that whoever sees you sees Him. Show us your face and we will be saved. Our newly installed *Pastoral Council* met on Saturday, June 20th to review the pastoral plan for the coming year. The next meeting will take place in October during which a Chairperson and Secretary will be elected by the members.

LAUDATO SI' (On the Care of Our Common Home) is the new Encyclical Letter of His Holiness, Pope Francis. In this important letter the Holy Father poses many challenging questions for the human family in its relationship with the world we share. The opening lines of the Encyclical Letter are taken from the famous prayer of Saint Francis of Assisi – the Canticle of Creation – *Praise be to you, my Lord.* In this prayer of praise he describes the earth as a sister

with whom we share our lives and a mother whose arms are open to embrace us. "The sister now cries out to us because of the pain we have inflicted on her by our irresponsible use and abuse of the goods with which God has endowed her" (LS, 2). The Pope presents Saint Francis of Assisi as "the example par excellence of care for the vulnerable and of an integral ecology lived out joyfully and authentically. He shows us just how inseparable is the bond between concern for nature, justice for the poor, and commitment to society and inner peace" (LS, 10).
