WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

FEAST OF MARY, MOTHER OF THE CHURCH

This ancient feast, celebrated the day after Pentecost, has recently been revived by His Holiness, Pope Francis. It invokes the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary who was entrusted by Jesus to the Apostle John at the foot of the Cross. He said to them - "Woman, here is your son. Here is your mother." Entrusting Mary to John was a loving act of care for his mother to ensure her well-being after his death. Entrusting John (and through him, all of us) to Mary's maternal care assures us of a powerful intercessor before God. Join us for the celebration of this feast on Monday, June 6 at **12:00 Noon** with Mass in the Cathedral Basilica.

MARIAN CHAPEL & DAILY MASS

Daily Mass (Tuesday through Friday at 8:00 a.m.) will move from the Cathedral to the Marian Chapel (Cathedral Basement) on Tuesday, June 7. The Chapel has been refreshed – carpets removed, painted and newly lighted (LED fixtures). It is also more economical to cool the smaller space in the summer than to cool the Cathedral each morning for Mass.

ORDINARY TIME RESUMES

The Season of Ordinary Time - which makes up most of the liturgical year - resumes with the conclusion of the Easter Season on Pentecost Sunday. We resume in the 10th Week in Ordinary Time. On Sundays for the coming months, we will hear the Gospel of Luke which will unfold the preaching, teaching and healing ministry of Jesus. Ordinary Time - and the liturgical year - concludes on the Feast of Christ the King celebrated on Sunday, November 20, 2022. May the coming days and months of Ordinary Time inspire us to follow Christ more faithfully as a member of the Church. Note that the Scripture readings for each Sunday, and for weekdays, are always listed in our Parish bulletin for your information. You may wish to add the reading of Scripture to your daily routine.
