WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

POPE FRANCIS

His Holiness, Pope Francis, announced on May 27th the appointment of the new Prefect of the Congregation of Divine Worship and Discipline of the Sacraments. The new Prefect is Archbishop Arthur Roche who had been serving as the Secretary of the same Congregation. The primary work of the CDW is to oversee the Church's implementation of the Second Vatican Council's teaching on the liturgy. It assists the Holy Father, and Conferences of Bishops, with matters pertaining to the liturgy in the life of the Church. Archbishop Roche and Bishop Crosby served on ICEL (*International Commission on English in the Liturgy*) for several years. The Archbishop has visited the Diocese and our Cathedral Parish in the past. We look forward to welcoming him here sometime in the future.

COVID LOCKDOWN & STAY HOME ORDERS

The Province of Ontario has announced that the current "stay home" order concluded on June 2. Further, the Province has announced that Ontario will be moving to re-open in stages beginning with Stage 1 on, or around June 14. Places of worship will be able to re-open in **Stage 2** which may be near the beginning of July. The re-opening will be with limitations – seating capacity at 15%, masks and social distance. Stage 3 will likely see those limitations relaxed somewhat. While it is disappointing to have a further delay in re-opening our Parish, it is comforting to know that there is a plan and the benchmarks that are necessary. One of those benchmarks is vaccination. All are encouraged to receive their vaccination and the follow up shot – the sooner we all do it – the sooner we'll return to a more normal pattern of life. Thanks to all for your patience and co-operation during this time.

CORPUS CHRISTI

Today we celebrate the *Feast of Corpus Christi* – the Body and Blood of Christ. This feast is an opportune time to review our practices around the reception of Our Lord in the Holy Eucharist.

FAST – we are encouraged to fast from food and drink (except water) for one hour before receiving Holy Communion.

DISPOSITION – we should recognize the immense gift given to us in the Eucharist and the privilege we have of sharing in it.

CONFESSION – if we are aware of serious, or even mortal sins, we should celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

How to receive?

The reception of Holy Communion is governed by particular law established by the Canadian Conference of Bishops and by the local Bishop. In his Pastoral Letter on the celebration of the liturgy in the Diocese of Hamilton, Bishop Crosby reminds us of how we are expected to receive Holy Communion at Mass. Namely, as we approach the minister distributing Holy Communion – usually as the person in front of us is receiving – we make a *simple* bow of the head in reverence for the gift we are about to receive. There is no need to genuflect or make a profound bow. Then, **standing** before the minister, the minister, holding up the Sacred Host says, *The Body of Christ*, and we say - audibly - "Amen." We open our hands to receive. (Due to COVID precautions, reception on the tongue is not permitted at this time). We do not take the Sacred Host with us to our pew.

Communion to the Sick

If you wish to take Holy Communion to a relative who is sick at home, please speak with Father Wynen prior to Mass – there is a special container and prayers for Communion to the Sick.

Reverence for Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament

When we pass in front of the Tabernacle, or go into our pew, it is customary to *genuflect* or bow in reverence. At the Cathedral Parish we have the custom that the assembly stands as the Blessed Sacrament is reposed in the Tabernacle after the distribution of Holy Communion. All are seated when the Tabernacle doors close.
