

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

#### PREPARATION FOR FIRST EUCHARIST

Please pray for the children and parents who are participating in the final preparation for the reception of Our Lord in Holy Communion. They will be meeting with our Pastoral Minister – Sandra Gould – for the next several weeks. We will have the joy of sharing in their first Holy Communion on Sunday, June 22 at the 11 a.m. Mass.

#### CHILDREN'S LITURGY

There has been an expression of interest in restarting the Children's Liturgy of the Word at Sunday Mass. In order for this to happen we will need some parent volunteers who would lead the sessions on a rotational basis. It would provide an opportunity for children aged 4 to 7 to celebrate the Liturgy of the Word and then re-join their parents for the remainder of the Mass. Training will be provided and volunteer screening (including an updated Police Records check and vulnerable sector screening) is required.
