## WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

### RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

As we celebrate the *Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)*, it seems an opportune time to review a few basics in regard to the reception of Holy Communion. It is an awesome privilege for us to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion.

We are a Church of *communion*. This means that the Mass we participate in is offered in union with all the Masses offered in the Diocese, through our Bishop our Mass is offered in union with all Catholics in the world and in union with our Holy Father.

Our celebration is meant to foster the unity of the Church. Even our actions as individual Catholics at the Mass speaks to the unity of the Church. This is why the Bishops of Canada have encouraged a common way to receive Holy Communion. Kneeling, or excessive gestures at Communion time, draw more attention to ourselves and away from the community, and from the Lord we receive.

1. Catholics receive Holy Communion in one of two ways only - either in the hand or on the tongue - we stand to receive Holy Communion as a sign of our reverence for the Lord.

2. If receiving in the hand ... be sure that your hands are open and free of anything - Kleenex, rosary, etc. Your right hand should cradle your left hand, like a throne. The minister says, "The Body of Christ." We respond, aloud, "Amen." The Sacred Host is placed on our hand. We take it with our right hand and place it in

our mouth, immediately. Do not walk away holding the Sacred Host. It is to be consumed in view of the minister.

3. To receive on the tongue, be sure your mouth is open so that the Sacred Host may be placed on your tongue. The minister says, "The Body of Christ." You respond "Amen" and open your mouth so that the Sacred Host may be placed on your tongue.

4. Non-Catholics may not receive Holy Communion at Mass because this is an act of *communion* with all that the Church teaches and believes. Non-Catholics may remain in their place and join us in prayer. The RCIA process begins in September for non-Catholics who wish to become members of the Church.

5. Please join in the song at Communion as a further sign of our unity. The silence following the distribution of Holy Communion is also meant to unite us in communal prayer.


### RCIA

The *Rites of Christian Initiation of Adults* is a process whereby adults welcomed into the Roman Catholic church through the Sacraments of Initiation. Adults who have not yet been baptized, or those previously baptized in another Christian denomination, may participate in this weekly gathering. Sessions focus on instruction in the Catholic faith, formation in spiritual life and moral teaching. The RCIA process in our Parish will begin in September ... but the summer months are a great time to meet with the Rector and discuss your participation in the process. If you, or someone you know, desires membership in the Catholic Church, please contact our Parish Office to arrange a time to meet with Father Dave.
