## WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

### RESUMPTION OF SUNDAY MASS

On Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup> Premier Ford announced that Churches in the Province of Ontario can re-open at 30% capacity. We are delighted that we can resume our celebrations with the People of God participating in person. The Diocese, and our Parish, want to ensure that we can re-open safely and so necessary pre-cautions will be temporarily enacted.

1. **Dispensation from Obligation** - Bishop Crosby has announced that Catholics in the Diocese of Hamilton are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass until further notice.

2. **Seating Capacity** - 30% capacity for us means approximately 270 people. Certain pews have been blocked to help with physical distancing. Members of the same household may sit together - others should maintain physical distance. Standing will not be permitted - once we have reached 30% latecomers will be invited to attend another Mass. The Cathedral will open 30 minutes prior to the beginning of each Mass.

3. **Music & Ministries** - the hymnbooks and missals have been removed. Our cantor will lead us in simple refrains and Mass parts. Our Parish choirs will not resume until further notice. One *Minister of the Word* will proclaim the Scripture readings. Extra-Ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will not be used for the time being.

4. **Reception of Holy Communion** - all are asked to receive Holy Communion in the hand. For those who prefer to receive on the tongue, we ask you to receive in the hand out of consideration for the Communion minister and all others who will receive. Note this is a temporary measure. Please follow the directions of the hospitality ministers who will direct one row at a time. Those on the sides move through the centre section as usual. We will distribute Communion to the East side first and then the West side.

5. **Departure at the end of Mass** - please follow the directions of our hospitality team members who will invite your departure by pew. Parishioners are asked to maintain physical distancing and avoid visiting after Mass. You may leave your offering envelope in the vault in front of the statue of Christ the King.

6. **Cleaning** – after each Mass the Cathedral will be locked so that it may be cleaned for the next Mass.

7. **Masks and gloves** – Parishioners are encouraged to wear a mask while at Mass. You may carefully remove it in order to receive Holy Communion by unhooking it from one ear. Gloves will be provided to those who assist with the cleaning of the Church after each Mass.

These are early days and temporary measures. Let us hope and pray that the virus dissipates sufficiently that we can return to regular operations.

#### SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENTS

##### **Daily Mass**

Note that our new Mass time is **11:45 a.m.** rather than 8 a.m. Mass will be celebrated in the Cathedral Basilica. Daily Mass resumes on June 16.

##### **Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession)**

This Sacrament will be celebrated in the *Marian Chapel* in the Cathedral Basement on Saturday mornings beginning at **11:00 a.m.** and concluding at 11:30 a.m. Use the side entrance and sit in the chairs along the hallway. Note that there are no confessions before Sunday or Daily Masses.

##### **Weekly Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament**

We normally take a break during the summer months with Adoration, and so we expect to return to weekly Adoration in September.

#### PARISH OFFICE

Our Parish Office re-opens on Tuesday, July 7<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m. Please note that there will be no “walk-ins.” Anyone wishing to visit the Parish Office must call in advance. Requests for Mass cards and certificates will be fulfilled with “curbside” pick up. Masks will be required of all visitors to the office.

#### A WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT ...

It will take sometime to return to a sense of “normal” in the Parish. Some may be hesitant to return to the celebration of Sunday Mass, others due to age, or physical condition, have chosen to stay home. Catholics should know that this is the reason the Bishop has extended the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. No one should feel pressured to return before they are comfortable. Monday, June 29, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Sts. Peter & Paul. It is one of the “Basilica feasts” ... days we are meant to observe with solemnity in the Basilica. We will celebrate Mass for the Feast Day at 11:45 p.m. The feast reminds us of these two great leaders of the Early Church – Peter, the rock on which the faith was founded, and Paul, its fearless preacher. This is also a day to pray for the Successor of Peter – our Holy Father, Pope Francis. May God give him health and strength to lead the Church.
