## WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

### FROM THE RECTOR ...

Today we celebrate the *Feast of the Holy Trinity*. This feast reminds us that God is love. The love of the Father for the Son; the Son for the Father; and the bond of love between them – the Holy Spirit. This Divine love bursts into our world in the beauty of creation, in the purity of human love, and in the loving service we offer one another in God's name. We sign ourselves with the cross and invoke the Holy Trinity every time we begin prayer, recall our baptism with holy water, and receive God's blessing. We offer the sacrifice of the Mass to the Father *through Him, and with Him, and in Him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit*. In doing so we are meant to offer our lives – our talents, gifts, each moment – to the Father, through Christ, in the Holy Spirit. This is the Christian life. #### CONGRATULATIONS GRADUATES

#### ONE HEART, ONE SOUL

We have recently completed the retrofitting of lighting in McNally Hall. The new “down lights” are dimmable LED fixtures. Our new kneelers are in production and we expect installation sometime in August. The sound system in McNally Hall will be upgraded and rough ins for the new Cathedral Basilica sound system will begin later this summer. At the same time, we anticipate upgrading our video and broadcast abilities - new cameras, monitors, and all that is necessary to livestream from the Cathedral Basilica. All thanks to the generous support we received from Parishioners through the *One Heart, One Soul* campaign.

#### PARISH OFFICE RE-OPENING

The Province has extended its emergency measure until June 30. As a result, our Parish Office remains closed. We are making plans for re-opening. There will be some new realities as the office re-opens. All requests for Mass cards and certificates must be made in advance by email or telephone. The completed Mass card or certificate may then be picked up at the front door at a mutually convenient time. All visitors to the Office are asked to wear a mask, or face-shield, and maintain physical distance.

#### RE-OPENING THE PARISH

The Bishops of Ontario are working with Provincial Officials, and each Diocese, to determine the timing and requirements to re-open Parishes for the celebration of weekday and Sunday Eucharist. Bishop Crosby will inform us of the adjustments to our usual practices. All are encouraged to co-operate with the temporary measures. Most importantly, those who are sick with cold or flu should stay home and recover. The Bishop’s dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass will remain in effect until further notice.
