The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

FEAST OF PENTECOST

Today the Church celebrates the great Feast of Pentecost when the Holy Spirit was poured into the hearts of the disciples gathered in the Upper Room. The sevenfold Gifts of the Holy Spirit gave the disciples a new heart and voice for proclaiming the Good News of Jesus' Resurrection. ORDINARY TIME

Two feasts are celebrated in the coming weeks – *the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity* and *Corpus Christi* – reminding us of the enduring presence of God whom we worship in every celebration of the Eucharist each week. 




