

WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

LITURGICAL PRACTICES IN TIME OF ILLNESS

As we learn more about the Covid-19 virus, spreading in various parts of the world and in our own country, there are questions about how this impacts our liturgical practices. The following is meant to offer some guidance.

- 1. We must *self-govern*. If we are sick with cold or flu or more serious illness there is NO OBLIGATION to attend Mass. In fact, it's best to stay home.
- 2. Frequent and thorough handwashing is a very effective weapon against illness. Note that there are hand sanitizers available at the entrances of the Cathedral Basilica.
- 3. The Sign of Peace can be exchanged in many ways. The simplest is to bow toward our neighbours at Mass, saying *Peace to you*. Shaking hands is not necessary and is not the gesture of the Sign of Peace. It's likely best to avoid shaking hands during cold & flu season.
- 4. The mode of receiving Holy Communion on the tongue or in the hand is left to the decision of the communicant. As a courtesy, during cold & flu season, one may wish to receive Holy Communion in the hand. Further direction may be offered by the Diocese in the even of a major viral outbreak.
- 5. Communion from the Chalice is the choice of the communicant. Those who have had a cold or flu may wish to avoid receiving from the cup. Further direction may be offered by the Diocese in the event of a major viral outbreak.

It is best to be aware of illness in ourselves or in our homes and allow that to dictate how we conduct ourselves in public places. Our maintenance staff work to ensure that our facilities are as clean as possible and ready for use each day.

Let us pray for the sick.

RITES OF SCRUTINY

Today we prayed with our Elect – Leslie and Dean – in light of the Gospel story of the conversation between Jesus and the woman at the well. The Rite of Scrutiny invites the Elect to reflect on the fact that it is Jesus Christ alone who satisfies the real thirst of our lives. He offers "living water" in the Sacraments, the Scriptures and the teaching of the Church, to strengthen us and bring us new life. The Rites continue next Sunday and on the Fifth Sunday of Lent as the Elect prepare for baptism at the Easter Vigil. Pray for them and for our candidates for full communion with the Catholic Church.
