

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

GOOD FRIDAY - FAST & ABSTINENCE

Good Friday is a *day of fasting and abstinence* for Catholics. Those who are 14 years old to those who have completed their 59th year (and are in good health) are required to fast. This might mean that

instead of eating three full meals – one might reduce their food intake to one or two meals for the day. The meals may be very simple. All Catholics are obliged to abstain from eating meat on Good Friday. Let us unite our efforts at these penances with the passion of the Lord who died so that we might live.

EASTER VIGIL

Join us for the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday at 8:00 p.m. It is described as the *mother of all vigils* and is the first celebration of the Lord's resurrection. This year we will celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation with four adults who wish to become members of the Catholic Church. The Easter Vigil is a bit longer than a regular Sunday Mass ... we begin with a celebration of light – Christ is the Light that extinguishes every darkness, then we listen to the story of Salvation as told through key passages of the Old Testament. Following the proclamation of the Easter Gospel we celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation with our adult candidates and renew our Baptismal Commitment before we gather at the Table of the Lord for the Eucharist.

BLESSING OF EASTER FOOD

Parishioners are invited to this traditional blessing of Easter foods which will take place in McNally Hall (Cathedral Auditorium) at 12:00 Noon. Each year we bless breads, pastries, lamb, wine, eggs and other traditional Easter foods ... oh and also wine!


