

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

#### 24 hours for Mercy

Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has asked each Diocese to set aside one parish church in which the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) may be celebrated for a 24 hour period. Bishop Crosby has designated the Cathedral Basilica for this purpose. So beginning at <u>4:30 p.m.</u> on *Friday, March 28<sup>th</sup>* and concluding at <u>4:30 p.m.</u> on *Saturday, March 29<sup>th</sup>* Priests will be available to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration during this time. To sign up for Adoration – please see the table at the back of the Cathedral.

Note that our previously scheduled Penance Celebration in Holy Week is cancelled ... please use this 24 hour period to celebrate the Sacrament in preparation for Easter.

Please pray for all who seek out God's merciful love in this wonderful Sacrament.

#### **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS**

Congratulations to our three *catechumens* who celebrated the Rite of Election with our Bishop on Sunday, March 9<sup>th</sup>. The Rite of Election marks their decision and the discernment of our team to call these individuals to the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil.

During these weeks of Lent they are called to prepare themselves with more intensive prayer and action for the reception of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

Today, and for the next two Sundays, we will celebrate the *Rites of Scrutiny* for the Elect. These Rites are based on the Gospel passages for these Sundays – the woman at the well, the man born blind, and the raising of Lazarus – all found in the Gospel of John. Having heard the passage proclaimed at Mass our community prays that the Holy Spirit will deepen the conversion experience of the Elect so that they will come to know Jesus Christ as our Saviour. The Elect then leave the Assembly to continue their reflection on the Gospel while the community continues its celebration of the Eucharist.

The Rites of Scrutiny will take place during the 9:00 a.m. Mass today, and on the Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent.

Our Elect are also joined by two baptized Christians who are seeking full communion with the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

Please pray for the Elect and our Candidates for full communion as the celebration of Easter draws near.
