WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

RITES OF SCRUTINY

Significant moments in the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* include the Lenten *Rites of Scrutiny*. These ancient rites take place on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent. Having heard the proclamation of John's Gospel stories of the *woman at the well; the man born blind; and the raising of Lazarus*, those preparing for the Easter Sacraments examine their lives in the light of Christ's mercy. These rites are a further sign of their desire to leave behind their former life and to embrace life in Christ in the Catholic Church. The Rites will be celebrated at the 11 a.m. Mass.

Preparing for Holy Week

The most important days of our Catholic year are soon upon us as we move toward Holy Week. You will notice a noble simplicity in the decoration of the Cathedral Basilica during these days. Our attention is focused on the Scriptures and the sacred actions of each day of Holy Week - particularly of the Sacred Triduum which begins on Holy Thursday and concludes on Easter Sunday. Let us prepare our hearts and minds for the renewal of our baptismal promises and enter fully into the joy of Lord's Easter, the celebration of the resurrection. Our feasting continues for 50 days after Easter concluding on Pentecost.

In the light of the Paschal Candle the Easter Sacraments of celebrated and our baptismal promises renewed. With joy we offer the first Eucharist of Easter. This is the "mother of all vigils."

Preparing for Reconciliation

Confessors will be available next Saturday, April 1 from 1:30 p.m. until 4:30 p.m. for those who wish to celebrate God's mercy and forgiveness in this wonderful Sacrament. Saint John Paul II was fond of saying that we "are not the sum of our faults and failings, we are the sum of the Father's love!" Come to confession ... even if it's been a long time ... the Lord waits for you and will receive your penance with joy and offer you his forgiveness. A few thoughts below to guide your examination of conscience. Jesus tells us that we are to love God with all our heart, mind and soul; and to love our neighbour as ourself.

Is prayer part of my daily routine? Do I attend Mass regularly on Sunday? Do I seek to learn about my faith and recognize the presence of God in my daily living?

My relationship with others ...

Have I supported outreach to the poor near home and/or around the world?

What anger or resentment do I harbour?

Am I struggling to be faithful in my marriage or committed relationship?

Do I waste time, money or talent?

Am I selfishly clinging to my possessions?

Do I look for constant affirmation from others to build myself up?

Is drug, alcohol or sexual addiction out of control in my life?

Do I exclude those closest to me from my daily life? Does pornography have a hold over me?
