#### **WELCOME!**

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

#### Campaign results in the Cathedral Parish

Thanks to all who donated to the Cathedral Basilica through the One Heart, One Soul Campaign. Our Campaign goal was \$500,000. To date we have received in pledges and donations \$867, 230 – with \$788,879 on hand.

Of the total collected funds 75% (\$650,422.50) is available for the designated projects. The remaining 25% went to shared Diocesan Projects (\$216,807.50).

All remaining funds will be transferred to our "funds on deposit" with the Chancery at the end of the Campaign.




