The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

SEVEN LIVELY VIRTUES/SEVEN DEADLY SINS

Join us for our Lenten Reflection Series with Fr. Robert Barron's video – *Seven Lively Virtues/Seven Deadly Sins* – we continue on Friday, March 6th with *Sloth*. March 13th we'll look at *Avarice* and March 20th *Gluttony & Lust*. Stations of the Cross begin at 7:00 p.m. and our session begins at 7:30 p.m. in McNally Hall. Fr. Barron's reflections are an excellent guide for this Lenten Season as we are called to turn away from sin and embrace the new life of the Gospel.



WHAT HAPPENED TO THE BELLS?

The work of the Cathedral Basilica's carillon (23 bells) will begin the week of March 9th. In preparation, and with the beginning of the Season of Lent, the bells have ceased ringing. Upon completion of this project – Easter Sunday – we'll have repaired the damaged parts of the Carillon and have a new, safe area for the clavier (keyboard). The work is being carried out by the Verdin Company. Upon completion we will have all 23 bells in working order and 5 bells connected to an electric strike system which will offer some variations in chime tones for different events – weddings, funerals, Mass time. Our carillon is one of about 50 that exist across Canada. We look forward to hearing our bells pealing out the call to prayer once again in the very near future.
