

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

The work of repointing the stone and roof replacement is moving along very well. The process of cleaning the exterior stone has begun on the Rectory and will continue at the Bishop's residence and the Cathedral. An eco-friendly cleaning agent is misted on the stone and then it is power-washed. Years of grime and dirt will be removed without damaging the stone. The repointing of the stone is nearly completed on the apse and the west side of the Cathedral. Work will continue on the east side and the tower. Thanks to all for your patience. Just a reminder ... any funerals celebrated on weekdays will be celebrated at either St. Thomas in Waterdown or at St. Mary's downtown. Saturday funerals and weddings should not impacted by the construction.
