#### WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

We begin the Rosary with the *Sign of the Cross* and the *Apostles Creed*. Using the beads above the crucifix we pray the *Our Father*, and three *Hail Mary's* – one each for faith, hope and love. Then the *Glory be* ... For each "decade" described above, begin with the *Our Father* followed by 10 *Hail Mary's* and finish with the *Glory be* ... At the end of the Rosary you may conclude with a Marian prayer – *Hail, Holy Oueen* or the *Memorare*.
