WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

TELEVISED MASS

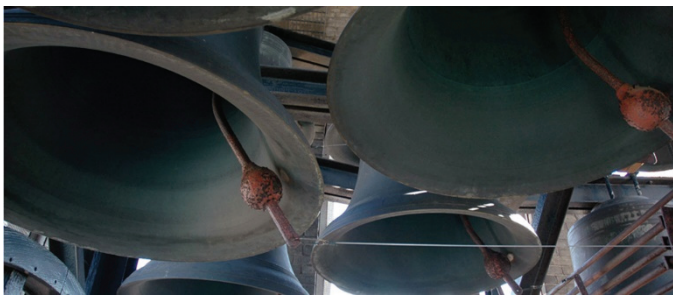

POPE SAINT JOHN PAUL II (1920 – 2020)

May 18th would have been Saint John Paul II's 100th birthday. John Paul was elected in 1978 at the young age of 58 and served as Supreme Pontiff until his death on April 2, 2005. Committed to the implementation of the Second Vatican Council, he has left a legacy of teaching and interpretation of the Council which will help to guide the Church for decades to come. His remarkable reign also saw him travel to more countries than any other pope. He also canonized and beatified more Christians than all the previous popes combined! He began the tradition of *World Youth Day* an annual observance on the Diocesan level with international gatherings every three or four years in various parts of the world. Even in his advanced years, he continued to appeal to the young with his great love for them and for the Lord. His episcopal motto was *Totus Tuus*. A dedication to the beloved Mother of God. Let us pray for the intercession of this great Pope as we seek to be disciples of the Lord in our present day!
