INTERESTED IN BECOMING A CATHOLIC?

EASTER SEASON

You may recall that the Lenten Season was a period of 40 days of *prayer, fasting and almsgiving*. Now the penance of Lent has given way to the joy of new life in the Risen Lord. The Easter Season is a period of 50 days of celebrating the Lord Jesus' victory over sin and death. It culminates with the *Feast of Pentecost* (June 9). During this time we hear at Mass from the *Acts of the Apostles* – the continuation of the Gospel of Luke in the New Testament. This book tells the story of the early Church through the preaching and travels of the first witnesses to Jesus rising from the dead – the Apostles. Although we do not emphasize the Penance of Lent – we do ask the help of God to deepen the spirit of conversion in our hearts. We are meant to continually turn toward God – who is always turned toward us! May these Easter days of joy strengthen each of us in living our vocation to Christian service.

2020 WEDDINGS

As we have outlined in the *One Heart, One Soul* Campaign information it is our intention to do some interior work at the Cathedral. We anticipate that this work would begin in mid-June 2020 and continue through the Summer and early Fall. As a result, we will not "book" weddings during these months – to avoid disappointment with the condition of the interior during the renovation work.
