

The Most Reverend D. DOUGLAS CROSBY, OMI, DD *Bishop of Hamilton*

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

POSTURE AFTER THE DISTRIBUTION OF COMMUNION

We would like to invite all parishioners to adapt a common posture after the distribution of Holy Communion and to observe a period of intentional silence before the *Prayer after Communion*. Once the Communion Ministers have returned to the Altar and the Blessed Sacrament is placed in the large ciborium all will **stand with the presiding priest** as the assisting priest carries the ciborium to the Tabernacle and reposes it. Once the Tabernacle doors have closed all will be **seated** for a moment of intentional silence during which we offer thanks to God for the gift of the Eucharist we have received. The presiding priest and the assembly will stand for the *Prayer after Communion*.

FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

Our Parish's Feast Day will be celebrated on Sunday, November 23rd – the Feast of Christ the King. This year we will welcome His Eminence, Gerald Cyprien Cardinal Lacroix – Archbishop of Quebec and Primate of Canada. Cardinal Lacroix will preach the homily at the 11:00 a.m. Mass that day. The Feast of Christ the King concludes the ordinary Sundays of the year. A new liturgical year begins with the Season of Advent on November 30th.
