

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

Today we celebrate the titular feast of our Cathedral Basilica. This feast was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 to honour Christ who is the servant King of all. Through his life-giving death and resurrection the crown of thorns becomes the crown of glory. We are called to follow Christ our King in loving service of others. This is a king of the towel and water, not of earthly triumph. His supreme act of self-sacrificing love on the cross is an example for each of us in our love and service of others. Today's feast concludes the Sundays of Ordinary Time.

SEASON OF ADVENT

Next Sunday, November 29, we begin a new liturgical year with the *First Sunday of Advent*. You may notice that the liturgical colour will change to purple ... a sign that we are waiting for the Lord's coming in the fullness of time, and preparing our hearts to celebrate his birth in Bethlehem 2000 years ago. In Advent the *Glory to God* is not sung at Sunday Mass. The other Mass parts are from a setting called "The People's Mass" by Jan Vermulst – you can listen to it by entering the title and composer into YouTube. This new setting will help to expand our Parish's musical resources. Thanks to Rob Corso, our cantors and choirs for leading us.
