WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - every eye shall see him.

The light of the wreath, like the light of Christ, helps dispel the darkness and warms our hearts with the hope of Christ's coming at Christmas and in the fullness of time!





"Enlarge the space of your tent" (Is. 54:2) is the title of the 44-page Working Document for the Continental Stage of the current synodal process the universal level. Bishop Crosby highlighted this document in his recent edition of Heart to Heart, which can be found on our Diocesan website - www.hamiltondiocese.com A link to the working document can be found there. The document reflects the 112 responses from the Bishops' Conferences (out of 114) and the 15 (out of 15) from the Oriental Catholic Churches received by the Synod Secretariat, as well as from the Vatican Dicasteries, the Institutes of Consecrated Life, the Ecclesial Associations and Movements, and more. The document was approved by the XV Ordinary Council of the Synod Secretariat publication, and presented at a Press Conference on Thursday, October 27th.


