The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

Couples who prepare well for the celebration of marriage are those who make faith and Sunday Mass a priority in their lives. The old adage is true ... couples who pray together, stay together. determining who can be married here, we give first preference to our own Parishioners. Couples from other Parishes, with the support of their Parish Priest, may be married at the Cathedral Basilica. In situations where the couple are not regularly supporting the Parish we request a donation for which an income tax receipt is issued on the day of the wedding. There are other fees associated with the celebration of a wedding at the Cathedral Basilica - including the organist, cantor, sacristan, servers and caretaker.
