

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*


CATHOLIC UPDATE

Dear Friends,

Since 1953 the Catholic community in the City of Hamilton has been blessed to have the services of the Catholic

Children's Aid Society of Hamilton. The work of the CCASH is the work of saving lives! Not only is this important for the entire Hamilton community, but it is vitally important for the children, youth and families who benefit from their care.

There are many ways to help children and families, but none more rewarding than opening your hearts and home to a child in need. In situations where parents are not able to safely care for their children, CCASH is committed to ensuring that children and youth have lifelong connections with their family and community. One critically important aspect of the Society's work is providing loving homes for the children in the care of the Society. These homes are provided by a dedicated group of individuals who act as foster families for the Society. Foster parents consider this mission both a privilege and an honour. They are examples of people who are living the gospel values and who believe their vocation as one of providing a commitment to the life of a child.

The Society currently is experiencing a shortage of foster homes and there is a critical need for families who would be open to fostering infants (children under 5) and adolescents (children and youth between 12 and 18). REMEMBERING THE DEAD

November is a traditional month for remembering those who have gone before us in life. Catholics pray for their deceased loved ones, and all who have died, each time we gather for the celebration of the Eucharist. Often members of the Parish will request that a particular intention be remembered at Daily Mass. If you would like to request a Mass intention please contact the Parish Office. In the month of November the Book of Remembering the Names of the Dead is placed near the Marian shrine in the Cathedral. We have inscribed the names of our deceased relatives and friends on these pages. They will be remembered at our Masses throughout the month of November. We believe that life is not ended in death - but through death we are born into Eternal Life with God.

AD RESUGENDUM CUM CHRISTO

"To rise with Christ" is the title of a recent instruction from the *Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith* published with the approval of Pope Francis. The Instruction clarifies the matter of cremation and the disposition of cremated remains for Catholics. The document does not add anything new to our current practices, however, it does serve as a timely reminder of our Catholic approach.

"Following the most ancient Christian tradition, the Church insistently recommends that the bodies of the deceased be buried in cemeteries or other sacred places." (Ad Resugendum Cum Christo, #3)

"In circumstances when cremation is chosen because of sanitary, economic or social considerations, this choice must never violate the explicitly stated or the reasonably inferable wishes of the deceased faithful. The Church raises no doctrinal objections to this practice, since cremation of the deceased's body does not affect his or her soul, nor does it prevent God, in his omnipotence, from raising up the deceased body to new life. Thus cremation, in and of itself, objectively negates neither the Christian doctrine of the soul's immortality nor that of the resurrection of the body." (Ad Resugendum Cum Christo, #4)

"In order that every appearance of pantheism, naturalism or nihilism be avoided, it is not permitted to scatter ashes of the faithful departed in the air, on land, at sea or in some other way, nor may they be preserved in mementos, pieces of jewelry or other objects." (Ad Resugendum Cum Christo, #7)
