MASS INTENTIONS

At each of our Weekday Masses in the Marian Chapel we remember the intentions offered by our Parishioners. These intentions are often for relatives or loved ones who have died. At our Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass we offer “multiple intentions.” This means that the Mass is offered for several deceased individuals. Remembering the deceased with Mass Intentions is a traditional Catholic practice.

PREPARING FOR THE FEAST

Our Parish’s patronal feast day – *Christ the King* – is observed on **Sunday, November 25th**. This feast was instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI. It is placed at the end of the Liturgical Year as its crown. The throne of our King is the Cross, and his crown was made of thorns. Our feast day is a good opportunity for us to celebrate and also to commit ourselves – once again – to following Christ the King through his saving Passion, Death and Resurrection. Thanks to our Parish Social Committee, we’ll enjoy coffee and treats after the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses on our Feast Day.
