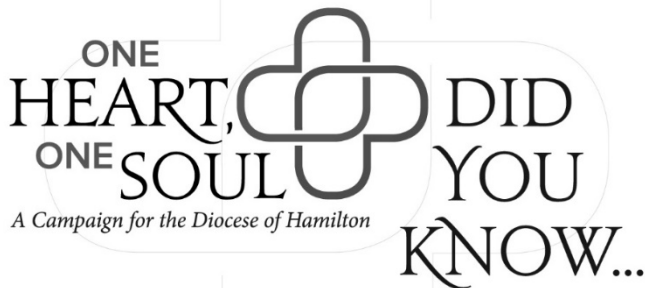
## MASS INTENTIONS

At each of our Weekday Masses in the Marian Chapel we remember the intentions offered by our Parishioners. These intentions are often for relatives or loved ones who have died. Sometimes they are for a special intention or for the needs of the living. At our Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass we offer "multiple intentions." This means that the Mass is offered for several deceased individuals. Remembering the deceased with Mass Intentions is a traditional Catholic practice. You may arrange for Mass Intentions for your relatives or loved ones by contact our Parish Office. The usual offering is \$10.00. We are now booking Masses in 2019.

## PREPARING FOR THE FEAST

Our Parish's patronal feast day - *Christ the King* - is observed on **Sunday, November 25<sup>th</sup>**. This feast was instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI. It is placed at the end of the Liturgical Year as its crown. The throne of our King is the Cross, and his crown was made of thorns. Our feast day is a good opportunity for us to celebrate and also to commit ourselves - once again - to following

Christ the King through his saving Passion, Death and Resurrection. Thanks to our Parish Social Committee, we'll enjoy coffee and treats after the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses on our Feast Day.

#### **What is the Diocese of Hamilton?**

The Diocese is an area of southeastern Ontario and a collection of 118 Parishes and 28 mission churches with 160 active priests. The Diocese aims to shepherd, support and serve Catholics in those Parishes and this region.

#### **Why does the Diocese need a campaign? Isn't it already financially sound?**

Yes, the Diocese is financially sound, and that stability is allowing the Diocese to conduct a campaign that focuses on the needs of Parishes, while also enhancing some Diocesan ministries. The campaign is part of the long-term vision for the Diocese, a vision of a thriving Diocese supporting thriving Parishes working to draw more people closer to Christ. The campaign has the potential to renew struggling Parishes and to make strong Parishes stronger.

#### **What are the Diocese's specific goals for the portion of funds it receives?**

Fifteen percent of the funds raised will go toward shared Diocesan ministries. These include campus ministry to college and university students as well as several ministries focused on those in need: hospital ministry, prison ministry and ministry to migrant workers.
