The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

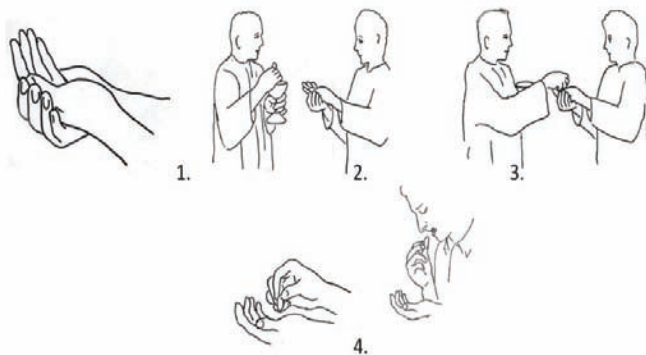
DOORS OF MERCY

The doors made for our observance of the Extra-Ordinary Holy Year of Mercy (East side entrance) will remain in place as a permanent reminder of the graces of this past year. Our thanks to the craftsmen who prepared these doors through which thousands of people have journeyed. Crossing this threshold is reminder that we enter into the heart of God through our life in the Church – the Word, the Sacraments, our community in Christ.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

The Bishops of Canada have indicated that it is desirable for Catholics who are receiving Holy Communion at Mass to first bow their head slightly – as a sign of reverence – you may do this while the person in front of you is receiving Holy Communion. Further, the posture for receiving Holy Communion is standing to receive either in the hand or on the tongue. To receive in the hand, place one open palm on top of the other. This demonstrates into which hand you expect to receive the Sacred Host. Say – “Amen” – aloud to the minister’s declaration “The Body of Christ.” Consume the Sacred

Host while standing in front of the minister. Receive the Sacred Host in your hand – do not take it from the minister or reach for it. Don’t raise the Sacred Host to your mouth in your palm. If you receive on the tongue please open your mouth after saying “Amen.” Those who choose to kneel are asked to be mindful of those around them – particularly the elderly and infirm – to avoid tripping hazards.
