100 SINCE THE END OF THE “GREAT WAR”

Sunday, November 11th marks the 100th anniversary of the end of World War I (1914 – 1918). We will observe this occasion at the beginning of the 11:00 a.m. Mass that day with a moment of silence and the singing of the National Anthem.

The Dominion Carillonner (Parliament Hill) has invited the eleven carillons in Canada to participate in a special observance on Remembrance Day. At 4:59 p.m. local time the bells will toll out 100 times. We are happy to participate in this important observance.

ELDERLY AND INFIRM PARISHIONERS

Parishioners who need assistance with their mobility while attending Mass at the Cathedral Basilica are invited to be seated in the first pew on each side of the centre aisle, the first pews on the side aisles. Ministers of Holy Communion go directly to these folks so that they don't have to move to receive Holy Communion. Please also use the elevator rather than the steps to enter and exit the Cathedral. Please note that the public areas of the Cathedral Basilica (including McNally Hall & washrooms) are fully accessible with the elevator. The Choir loft is for choir members and musicians only ... there is no public access to the Choir loft.

VISITS WITH SENIORS & HOMEBOUND

We plan to establish a ministry of care which will include parishioners willing to visit with our Seniors and with homebound parishioners. Training will be provided and volunteer screening is necessary. This would be a

rewarding opportunity for adults who are seeking to volunteer in a meaningful way. The ministry will also include assisting with monthly Communion Services at Parkview and Shalom Village.
