WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

Due to COVID restrictions, we will not display the "Book of Life" in the Cathedral Basilica. Instead, you may write down the names of your deceased relatives and friends and bring it with you to Mass. You may leave the paper on which you have written names in the basket near the Marian Shrine. These names will be remembered at our liturgies in November.

WHEN WILL NEW MISSALS BE AVAILABLE?

Due to COVID restrictions we will not place new Sunday Missals in the pews. You will have the opportunity to purchase your own Missal and bring it with you to Mass. On the *Feast of Christ the King* (November 22) we will have 2021 Missals for sale in McNally Hall ... it will also be an opportunity to pick up your offering envelopes and to make your "reservation" for Christmas Masses.

MASS ETIQUETTE DURING PANDEMIC

Note that we are asked to leave Church immediately at the end of the Mass so that our volunteers can begin disinfecting the pews. 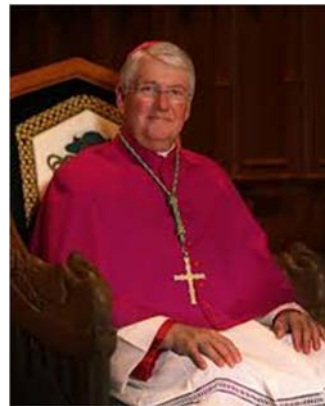
WELCOME TO ASSUMPTION PARISH

FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

The *Feast of Christ the King* on Sunday, November 22 is our Parish's patronal feast day. It marks the 38th anniversary of the solemn dedication of the Cathedral by Bishop Paul F. Reding on November 21, 1982 following the renovations necessitated by the damage caused by the 1981 fire. The *Feast of Christ the King* also marks the conclusion of the liturgical year. The First Sunday of Advent (November 29) is the start of a new liturgical year during which we will follow the "Year B" cycle of readings. On most of the Sundays of *Ordinary Time* the Gospel passage will be taken from Mark's Gospel. In Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter we'll hear passage from the Gospels of Luke and John.
