

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishop's 2015 Federal Election Guide

The Canadian Federal Election is on Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup>. All Canadians with the right to vote should exercise their democratic responsibility. Here is an example of the application of Catholic moral and social teaching to consider as the election nears:

#### 5. A healthy country in a healthy environment

Protecting the environment means, among other things: \*Implementing responsible stewardship practices for the environment;

- \*Honouring international agreements to reduce greenhouse gas emissions;
- \*Reducing our dependence on fossil fuels;
- \*Taking steps to control urban pollution;
- \*Introducing forms of transportation that are less harmful to the health of citizens and the environment;
- \*Encouraging companies to invest in renewable energy and energy efficiency;
- \*Developing natural resources without harming the quality of life in communities;
- \*Protecting water as an essential resource;
- \*Bequeathing a sustainable and healthy environment to future generations.
