The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

Beginning this weekend, we will offer Holy Communion under both species – the Body and Blood of Christ – at our Sunday Masses. Receiving from the Chalice is the option of the communicant. We offer the Eucharist in this way because it is a fuller sign of the reality we celebrate in the Mass. Please note that you may not dip the Sacred Host into the Chalice – we always take and eat, take and drink. If you do not wish to receive Holy Communion from the Chalice you may wish to bow before the Chalice as you pass by on your way to your pew.
