

WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.



FEAST OF SAINT JOHN PAUL II



The feast day of Saint John Paul II is on Thursday, October 22. He was elected to the Chair of Peter on October 16, 1978 and was inaugurated as Pope on October 22 the same year. He said he took the name of "John Paul" in honour of his successor - Pope John Paul I who reigned for 33 days. The name also joins the legacies of Pope Saint John XXIII and Pope Saint Paul VI - who called for and oversaw the Second Vatican Council (1962 - 1965). Saint John Paul II continued the important work of the implementation of the Council's teaching. He also promulgated the revised Code of Canon Law (1983) and the Catechism of the Catholic Church (1985). Saint John Paul's long reign (27 years) saw the canonizations of hundreds of Saints. He visited nearly every country of the globe – some more than once. We pray for his intercession in heaven.

WEDDINGS FOR 2021

We have many couples planning to marry at the Cathedral Basilica in 2021. All, but three couples from 2020 transferred to 2021 due to the COVID lockdown. Our advice to these couples is to plan their wedding based on the information we have today. It's easier to add people to the guest list, than it is to disinvite due to restrictions. Wedding ceremonies can be celebrated with 30% capacity of the Cathedral

Basilica ... this does not apply to reception venues. We are already "booking" weddings for 2022!
