#### **WELCOME!**

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him*.

#### RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Adults who have not been baptized, or baptized in another Christian church, who wish to become members of the Catholic Church are invited to contact our Parish Office regarding the RCIA In-person sessions, for the fully vaccinated candidates and participants will begin on Wednesday, September 22. Masks will be required and social distance will be observed.

#### RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

Parishioners are invited to receive Holy Communion, standing, either in the hand or on the tongue. Please note that masks must be worn the entire time one is in the Cathedral, including at the time of Holy Communion. If receiving in the hand, step aside, remove the mask and consume the Sacred Host. receiving on the tongue, after saying "Amen" remove your mask to receive, then replace your mask and return to your pew.

#### FOR THE COMMON GOOD

All who are eligible for the COVID vaccine should be fully immunized for their own health and for the common good. This is the consistent message of the Catholic Church our Holy Father, the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, and our own Bishop. There can be no religious exemption for Catholics because the Magisterium of the Church has clearly supported receiving the vaccine. Some may object on the grounds of conscience, which is their right, but it must be a well-formed conscience. Sadly, there is much misinformation misunderstanding, conspiracy theories on the internet. This has caused some to be fearful of the vaccine or to believe that it has some nefarious purpose. Vaccines have helped to eradicate once common diseases - polio, small pox, etc - let's hope and pray that wide use of the vaccine will help to eradicate this pernicious virus.
