

RCIA

The *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* is the process by which unbaptized adults can become fully initiated members of the Catholic Church. The Rites are celebrated at intervals that lead up to the celebration of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday.
