

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

The Cathedral Basilica Pastoral Council met on Saturday, September 17. Members received updates on the progress of restoration, the Year of Mercy, and the coming Pastoral Year. Plans for our Fall Adult Education Series and the Lenten Reflection Series were discussed. results of the Parish-wide consultation on refugee resettlement were reviewed by members. Pastoral Council concurs that there is not sufficient support to form a committee to assist in the settlement of a refugee through our Parish. Those individuals who did express interest in forming a committee will be invited to join a committee in one of the Parish's in the City of Hamilton. The Parish Finance Council will consider offering financial support to one of these committees in another Parish. The Pastoral Council meets four times per year and our next meeting is scheduled for Saturday, November Thanks to the members for their participation and to Dino LeDonne our Council's chair.
