

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin - *every eye shall see him.*

Examples of the application of Catholic moral and social teaching

The following are examples of how Catholic moral and social teaching is to be applied. They do not constitute a political platform but a magnifying glass by which to analyze and evaluate public policies and programs.

3. The person and the family

Promoting the integrity of the person and family includes:

- *Promoting a better balance between familial and professional responsibilities;
- *Ensuring pay equity between men and women;
- *Guaranteeing sufficient basic income for an adequate quality of life;
- *Providing access to quality hospital care for all;
- *Supporting the reunification of immigrant and refugee families;
- *Taking actions against human trafficking;
- *Promoting the rehabilitation of criminals through restorative justice and ensuring support for their victims;
- *Protecting people from addictions to drugs and gambling.
