This celebration reminds us of our ongoing need to pray for vocations and to encourage those who might be considering a priestly vocation. Might there be someone in your family or circle of friends who is experiencing a call to the priesthood?

"Quo Vadis" is the Latin phrase for "Where are you going?" Legend tells us that St. Peter asked Jesus this question on the outskirts of Rome. And we know where Jesus went in response to His Father's will. 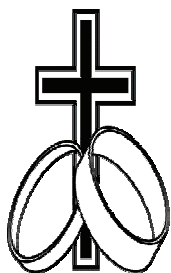

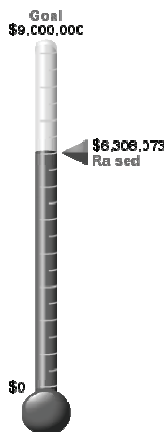
