PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

From Fr. Tom...

I read a simply written, beautiful old book called *The Day Christ Died*, by Jim Bishop (1957). It is written by a reporter, and provides an hour by hour narrative of the last 24 hours of Jesus' life. Inspired by this, here is an overview of the last week of Jesus' life as we begin Holy Week.

Saturday:

Jesus arrives in Bethany six days before Passover, stays with Lazarus, Mary and Martha. Possibly the supper and anointing in Bethany at the home of Simon the leper where Jesus is anointed by Mary.

Palm Sunday:

Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Spends the night in Bethany.

Monday:

Jesus leaves Bethany, curses the fig tree on the way into the city, weeps over seeing Jerusalem and predicts its destruction. Jesus cleanses the temple, then leaves the city, and spends the night in Bethany.

Tuesday:

Jesus leaves Bethany, finds the fig tree withered. Jesus denounces the scribes and Pharisees.

Jesus teaches in the Temple, and leaves the city to return to Bethany. Judas bargains with Sanhedrin to betray Jesus.

Wednesday:

Silent day... no record in the Gospels. Jesus prepares for the Last Supper, and Judas and Sanhedrin prepare for Jesus' arrest.

Holy Thursday:

The Last Supper. Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane; the betrayal of Judas and the arrest of Jesus. Jesus taken to Annas, the father-in-law of Caiaphas, the high priest. Annas sends Jesus to Caiaphas. Jesus taken to the high priest Caiaphas' home where the scribes, elders, and the chief priests had gathered. Peter denies Jesus three times. Jesus was kept overnight in a cistern below Caiaphas' home.

Good Friday:

Early in the morning, the Sanhedrin meets, they lead Jesus to Pilate. Pilate sends Jesus to Herod. Herod mocks Jesus and then clothes him in gorgeous apparel, and sends Jesus back to Pilate. Pilate examines Jesus and finds him not guilty of the Jew's charges against him. Pilate has Jesus flogged and plans to release him. Jesus is crowned with thorns. Jesus is sentenced to death and is crucified at 9:00 in the morning. Jesus dies at 3:00 and is buried in the tomb.

Holy Saturday:

Jesus' body in the tomb. Guard keeps watch in front of the tomb.

Easter Sunday:

Early in the morning of the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome brought spices to anoint Jesus' body. The stone had been rolled away, the tomb was open, the body was gone, and they were told by an angel (two angels, a young man or two men in white clothes) that Jesus had been raised, and to go tell the disciples that Jesus has risen and would see them in Galilee. The disciples did not believe the women, but Peter ran to the tomb. Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene and tells her to go to the disciples. She is the first person on record to see the risen Jesus.

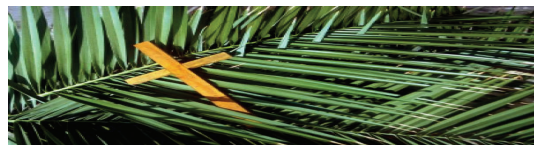
HOW DO I BECOME CATHOLIC?
