Holy Spirit Festival

It is the time of the year when we begin to prepare for the Holy Spirit Festival at St. Michael's. The celebration of the crowning originated centuries ago with St. Elizabeth II (or Isabel), Queen. In the 13th century, when Portugal was in the grips of a famine, Isabel prayed to the Holy Spirit to spare the Portuguese people from starvation. Soon after, ships arrived in the port of Lisbon, and their cargo relieved the country from certain disaster. Isabel then summoned the citizens of the country, both rich and poor, and they gathered in the royal chapel to celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving. When the "Come Holy Spirit" was chanted, Isabel chose a humble peasant girl from the crowd. As an act of humility, she had the bishop place the royal sceptre in the peasant's hands and the royal crown on her head – hence the tradition of the crowning's.

For the seven weeks leading up to the feast (known as Domingas) the crown of the Holy Spirit is brought into a family's home and that family will open their home to parishioners who gather each night of the week to say the rosary and sing hymns of praise to the Holy Spirit. On the following Sunday we have a ceremonially crowning of the family as we pray for the grace of the Holy Spirit to come upon them.

The Crown or "Coroa", consists of three individual pieces. The Sceptre of the Crown is accented by a dove, the symbol of the Holy Spirit whose love was so manifested in Saint Isabel's life. The Crown has a double significance: first, it represents the supreme dominion of the Holy Spirit, and second; the Crown represents the royalty of Queen Isabel. The Plate, serving as a stand for the Crown and the Sceptre, represents the people. If we are to be true followers of Jesus Christ, we must serve others. As a plate holds food which is given to the hungry, so are we called to actively serve, like Queen Saint Isabel. Not only to be touched by God's Holy Spirit, but to see that divine transformation into the visible reality of serving others in their spiritual, physical, and emotional needs.

The Holy Spirit Festival will be celebrated at St. Michael's Parish on June 5th at 12 pm with a Bilingual Portuguese-English Mass and followed by a procession and meal at the Portuguese Club. All are invited to attend and participate in this celebration.
