From Fr. Tom... April 28 and May 5, 2019

Every year on the Second Sunday of Easter, we also remember the gift of Divine Mercy. Divine Mercy Sunday is focused on Christ's limitless mercy and love for all people. This devotion is based on the writings of Sister St. Faustina Kowalska. A good book for spiritual reading is her diary: "Divine Mercy in my Soul".

Part of the observance of Divine Mercy Sunday includes the opportunity for the faithful to receive a **Plenary Indulgence**, a remission of the temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The "usual" conditions for seeking a Plenary Indulgence are Sacramental Confession, Reception of the Holy Communion and Prayer for the Pope's intentions. Additionally related to Divine Mercy Sunday is that one must receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation within 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday, receive Holy Communion on or near the day, and pray the Divine Mercy chaplet or other suitable Divine Mercy prayer as specified by the Church.

How to Recite the Chaplet:

The Chaplet of Mercy is recited using ordinary rosary beads of five decades. The Chaplet is preceded by two opening prayers from the Diary of Saint Faustina and followed by a closing prayer.

1. Make the Sign of the Cross

2. Optional Opening Prayers

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat three times)

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

- 3. Our Father
- 4. Hail Mary
- 5. The Apostle's Creed
- 6. The Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

7. On the Ten Small Beads of Each Decade

For the sake of His sorrowful

Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

8. Repeat for the remaining decades

Saying the "Eternal Father" (6) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (7) on the following "Hail Mary" beads

9. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

10. Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your Holy Will, which is Love and Mercy itself.
