## **Third Sunday of Easter-April 30, 2017**

From the Desk of Fr John:  
I have a number of items for today.

**1. Building Update** – We continue to work with the architect and the contractor to correct the deficiencies of the building. Many are minor things that have to be corrected! There are, however a couple of larger items that need to be corrected. The wall behind the altar with the Cross on it has a couple of horizontal cracks in it. These may take some time to repair and may affect some of our weekday Masses. The second major item is that we have a leaky roof! The evidence of this problem is most noticeable in the hallway off of the Narthex and in the washrooms located there. The work on this will begin on May 2<sup>nd</sup>. I will keep you informed.

**2. First Communions** – Many young people will be receiving the Eucharist for the first time today and over the coming weeks! Let us pray for them and their families as they celebrate this wonderful occasion.

**3. Ordination to the Priesthood** – It is with great joy that I draw your attention to the fact that Bishop Fabbro will be ordaining Deacon Glen Ball to the Ministerial Priesthood on May 13<sup>th</sup>. Please keep Deacon Glen in your prayers as he prepares for this day! Let us also pray for our Director of Vocations and Seminarians, Fr. Patrick Beneteau, as he continues to journey with young men considering a call to the Priesthood.

**4. Fr. Danny Santos** – Fr. Danny will be leaving this coming week and journeying to Portugal. He will be at Mass with Pope Francis on the 13<sup>th</sup> of May - the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first apparitions of Mary to three little children, Lúcia Santos and her cousins Jacinta and Francisco Marto. We wish him God Speed! I am sure that he takes our prayers with him!

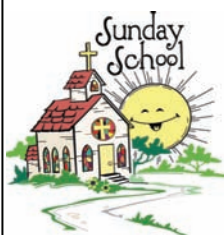
## SMYL YOUTH MINISTRY - MY MAMA
