Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

There is a new video available from the Euthanasia Prevention Coalition entitled: The Deception of Assisted Suicide. In our day and age this issue is a tragic avoidance of life's sufferings and ultimately a dehumanizing of every person in society. The decision to avoid pain and suffering by taking the easy way out by having a doctor administer death is based on fear and feelings. Palliative care is the dignified way that leads to peace and tranquility in the face of death.

We have good examples to learn about this from the lives of our beloved relatives who have taken the path of suffering to find eternal life. One great example is in St. John Paul II who accepted his aging weakness and continued to lead the church on his way to the home of our Father in heaven.

Great good can come from suffering. Endurance produces strong character traits. We appreciate this in an athlete who succeeds through years of rigorous training. Only think of the men and women in the Olympic games in Rio. We also witness this in a person battling an incurable disease. Suffering is simply part of the human condition, and when embraced and "gone through", it strengthens the human soul.

This weekend, a group of fourteen married couples are facing the suffering of marital conflict in their Retrouvaille weekend retreat at Holy Family Retreat House. Instead of blaming each other or blaming God for their heart-aches, they are rediscovering the spark of their mutual commitment and promise "to be true to each other in sickness and in health until death" as they lovingly proclaimed on the day of their sacramental union in matrimony. They will learn, perhaps for the first time, and practice the tools of human communication to overcome the pain of conflict in their relationships. Please pray for these couples at our Masses this weekend.

In the Gospel today, Jesus said that there are two roads we can follow.

The first is wide and easy to travel.

It is downhill most of the way.

It is the way of comfort and ease, pleasure and self-seeking.

Many are fooled and travel down this road.

But in the long run it leads them nowhere. They die in the desert.

The second road is narrow and difficult.

It is uphill a lot of the way. It is the way of struggle and sacrifice.
