From Fr Tom...

As we begin September, many programs and many groups in our parish, which have paused for the summer, will soon start back up again.

This year we are going to invite people from every group in our parish to pray for their members and for our parish and pray for the gifts of the Holy Spirit to be renewed in all of us.

On **Sunday, August 26th**, from **6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.**, we will have **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** for a time of Eucharistic adoration and prayer. I ask that the leaders and members of our different groups ensure that at least one person from their groups come for a few minutes during that time to pray on their behalf. Of course, *all parishioners* are invited and welcome to come for some time to drop in and pray that evening.

Some intentions you make ask the Lord during this time of prayer:

- For a blessing on all the activities of our parish over the next year
- For the RCIA and those who may be feeling a call to be Catholic
- For peace and grace in the families of our parish
- For the healing of victims and survivors of sexual abuse and their families, for our communities, and for the reparation of the sins of abusers

Here is a prayer to begin your time of prayer in front of the Blessed Sacrament:

My Lord and my God, I firmly believe that you are here; that you see me, that you hear me. I adore you with profound reverence; I beg your pardon for my sins, and the grace to make this time of prayer fruitful. My Immaculate Mother, Saint Joseph my Father and Lord, my guardian angel, intercede for me. (St. Escriva)

If you have never prayed in Eucharistic Adoration before, I will have a resource called: **Fifteen Minutes in the Company of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament**. A table with copies will be available in the Church when you come on Sunday night.
