## Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Thank you for your prayers and support of the couples who made their Retrouvaille retreat last weekend. Thanks also to the couples who shared their experience and inspired everyone to build confidence in their marital commitments and to communicate life-giving love to each other and to their families and to all of us in the Church whom Jesus claims as his beloved Bride. Thanks to Our Lord for sustaining the generosity of so many in increasing this ministry for couples whose marriages are hurting. This healing ministry is needed in our lives, and our general society would rather promote divorce than the deeper ministry of love and healing. There is a movement now in the United States to do what we can to eradicate divorce from our culture. It is totally Christ-centered and fed by the Word of God. Please encourage anyone you know who is experiencing the pain of marital conflicts to look into Retrouvaille as an effective program of moving through the painful experience to the roots of love deeply planted in every human heart.

*"Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."* So ends Jesus' teaching on places at the table in the Kingdom. He criticizes those who thrust themselves forward and engineer their way to the top. The parable teaches us that honour in the Kingdom comes from the host and not from the guest. God confers honour on those who are humble. All of us are learning this lesson in our parish family as we come together under one roof at the invitation of Jesus himself to strengthen our Christian family and with humility open our celebrations of faith to everyone without placing barriers in the way of anyone the Lord is calling to take a place at His table. Thanks to all the members of our transition committee and liturgical committee working with Simone as we pass through this time in our parish history.

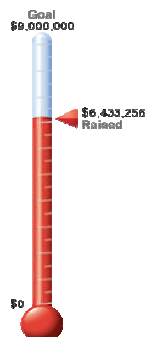
