Coming soon: Wednesday, August 19th – Father Suarez and Father Shannon will lead us in a Mass of Healing. The Rosarv will begin at 6:00 p.m. followed by Divine Mercy devotions at 6:15 p.m. Mass is at 7:00 p.m. and immediately following will be prayers of healing with Father Suarez. A tent in front will be available for an overflow crowd. Parking is available on near-by streets and in the parking lots of the Lutheran Church and the Faith Mennonite

Church. We also highly recommend if you're coming with family and friends, that you car pool together as parking will be limited to handle such a large crowd. A collection will be taken to help the ministry of Mary, Mother of the Poor, in the Philippines.

In these Sunday Masses, we continue to hear Jesus' teaching on the Bread of Life, his very Body and Blood, in the Gospel of John 6. To help us make the connections with his self-gift and the Mass, Achim Klaas has delivered the finished 'corpus' which will be mounted on a large Cross in our new sanctuary, and has been placed temporarily at St. Joseph's. The celebrant's chair will be installed to the right of the altar, as it will be in the new church. When we meditate on the self-giving Sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross, we grow in our awareness that his sacrifice is once and for all present to us in our own participation by uniting our sacrifices with his, out of love for God and for the whole of mankind. We are invited now to develop our devotion to Jesus who is at the centre of our Christian lives, nourishing us with life eternal even now. As Father Chris points out in his Apologetics program, the virtue of religion is DEVOTION, and this beautiful work of art will draw out our heart-felt response to the love of our Lord who pours out his life for us sinners, and as we enter into the response by pouring out our lives for him.

Michelangelo, the great Italian sculptor, described the work of the artist as removing the excess material (marble or wood) until the figure contained within it appears. We have with Achim's masterful work a good example of this. Wood shavings from the carving are available for anyone who would like to have them as a remembrance of our common effort to prepare a new sanctuary worthy of our parish community that gives glory to God. These are available in response to your financial contribution towards the new Crucifix that will be in the new St. Michael's. Please ask for a sample at the office.
